He certainly never would have imagined that they would be shown on television - it was invented just three years before he died in 1930. But his incredible stories have stood the test of time, and have continued to be popular for over 140 years.

Sherlock Holmes has appeared in many films and television series, and most of them are very similar to the original stories. But British writer Mark Gatiss has given the famous detective a new, 21st-century life with all the latest technology in the BBC TV series Sherlock. And it works brilliantly! The series is fast, modern, and exciting to watch.
